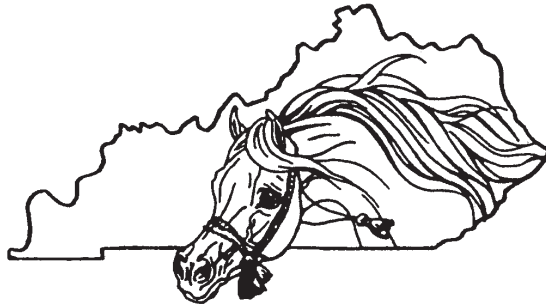

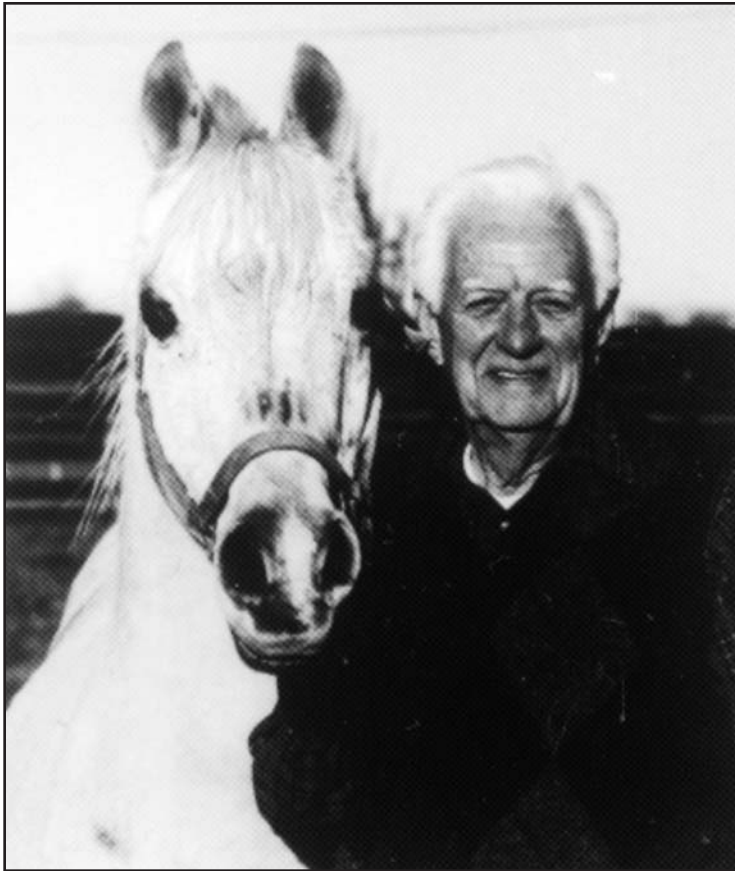

ANYONE OCCUPYING A STALL (OR STALLS) NOT ASSIGNED TO THEM BY SHOW MANAGEMENT WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE FOR THE STALLS.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Early arrivals can be stalled at \$40 per day, per stall. Please contact Tony Conner for arrangements. Early arrivals or late night arrivals should notify Tony of arrival times!! Anyone occupying stalls before 12 p.m. on March 31, 2011 for Festival or 12 p.m. on April 4, 2011 for Bluegrass Classic only exhibitors will be considered an early arrival and will be charged accordingly. Stalls occupied after 8 a.m. on April 2, 2011 (FESTIVAL) or 8 a.m. on April 4, 2011 for Bluegrass Classic only exhibitors will also incur additional charges. Stall reservations will only be made from the entry forms. Stall cards will be placed on stall doors — Do Not Remove! Stalls WILL NOT be reserved without payment of all stall and entry fees! NO STALL RESERVATION WITHOUT ENTRIES.
2. All stalls have doors. Most stalls have sliding doors. NO bedding will be provided by the shows. Shavings only may be used in the stalls. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled with another exhibitor should state so when entries are sent in. The Show Management will make every effort to comply with these requests. (Contact Deaver Hay & Grain, 859-233-9702, to reserve shavings! Credit Card required to order shavings!)
3. No parking between the barns, in aisles, barn area or at end of barns!
4. A parking permit fee of \$5.00 will be charged to all vehicles by the Kentucky Horse Park entering the Horse Park. There is no charge to exhibitors for admission to the show. All Exhibitors MUST display their Exhibitors parking pass at all times or they will be TICKETED by the Park Police! **ANYONE DRIVING A GOLF CART MUST HAVE A DRIVERS LICENSE! There is a private golf cart fee! See Deaver's.**
5. POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED NO LATER THAN THE BEGINNING OF THE SESSION PRECEDING THE SESSION WHOSE CLASSES YOU ARE ENTERING.
6. Two or more entries constitute a class. Exhibitors will be notified and entry refunded if a class is canceled. Classes may be canceled, combined, split, entries limited or elimination's held upon the discretion of the Show Management.
7. Protests: All protests must be filed as set forth in USEF rules. Anyone desiring to speak to a Judge must make an appointment with the Show Steward who will arrange a meeting.
8. A drug fee of \$15 per horse per show will be charged. (\$7, Drugs /Meds; \$8, USEF)
9. Excessive use of the whip or cruelty in any form is grounds for dismissal of individuals from further showing in the Bluegrass Spring Festival and the Bluegrass Classic. The Show Management reserves to itself the right to remove the horse's owner, trainer, groom, rider, and/or handler from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.
10. Hoof length and shoe type and weight governed by USEF rules.
11. All exhibitors will be expected to dress in appropriate attire while showing. This includes appropriately dressed headers permitted in the ring for the driving classes.
12. No substitution of horses will be permitted.
13. In addition to entries of persons suspended or expelled from USEF, the Bluegrass Spring Festival and the Bluegrass Classic Shows Management reserves the right to refuse the entry of any exhibitor. Any Exhibitor who owes money to AHA, any AHA club or Region will not be allowed to show until this debt has been paid. Anyone who gives this club a NSF check will be required to pay in cash or cashiers check until further notice.
14. In the event of illness or failure of a Show Official to attend these shows or perform their duties, the Show Management reserves the right to substitute a Show Official.
15. Classes will be called promptly. TWO MINUTES will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Exhibitors are cautioned that if entering the same horse in successive classes, a tack change should be arranged for with the Paddock Master. Tack changes will be limited to three (3) minutes per class.
16. All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times! THEY WILL BE IMPOUNDED!
17. Camper space is available. Make arrangements with the Kentucky Horse Park, Lexington, Kentucky. Phone 859-233-4303. (First Come First Serve)
18. There will be a \$50 service charge for all RETURNED CHECKS!
19. Prize money will be mailed within 30 days of the show. No prize money will be distributed at the show or credited to accounts.

20. No refunds on scratched entries.
21. Jumper classes will be conducted under USEF JP 143.3, Table 2, Section 2 (b)
22. Exhibitors may qualify for Regional Championship Hunter/Jumper classes at either the Bluegrass Spring Festival or the Bluegrass Classic. Horses qualifying at either of these two shows will not be required to pay a post entry fee.
23. A no-scratch fee of \$10 per class will be charged all exhibitors who do not scratch a class with the Show Secretary or Paddock Master prior to the call of the class.
24. No photographers except OFFICIAL SHOW PHOTOGRAPHERS will be allowed to take photographs at the show without permission of show manager.

DEFINITIONS

1. A NOVICE HORSE is defined as a horse which has not won three first ribbons at Regular Member Shows of the USEF or the CEF in the particular performance Division in which it is being shown.
2. A MAIDEN HORSE is one which has not won a first ribbon at a Regular Member Show of the USEF or the CEF in the particular performance division in which it is being shown. A Maiden entry is such from the date of the closing of entries.
3. A JUNIOR EXHIBITOR are those exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2010. The age of an individual on December 1, 2010 shall be maintained throughout the entire year of 2011
4. A LIMIT HORSE is defined as a horse which has not won six first place ribbons at Regular Member shows of USEF or CEF in the particular performance division in which it is being shown. A limit entry is such from the date of the closing of entries.

REGISTRATION PAPERS

Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horses one (1) year of age or over must be registered or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for. A copy of the registration papers of each horse entered in this show must be sent with entries. Copies of both registrations must be sent for horses being shown in both the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All horses (12 months for Kentucky horses & 12 months for out-of-state horses) exhibited at this show are required to have a Negative Coggins test. All out-of-state horses are required to have a current (within the past 30 days) Certificate of Health. It is mandatory for Kentucky horses to have a current health certificate which is only good for 5 months in Kentucky. These must be presented to the **STATE VET PERSONNEL** upon arrival.

THE STATE VET WILL BE SET UP IN A TRAILER JUST PAST THE HORSE PARK HORSE RENTAL BARN. No exhibitors packet will be given out until the horse's health papers are passed by the state health officer present. **DO NOT** submit your Coggins test certificate with your entries. Keep the certificate in your possession until such time as it is requested.

AHA MEMBERSHIP

Any trainer, driver, rider or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horses at the shows must be a competition member of the AHA or pay a single event non member fee of \$30 per show. Competition membership is required for all of the above in Regional shows.*****
MEMBERSHIP AFFIDAVIT FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR VERIFICATION OF MEMBERSHIP!

USEF STATEMENT
(See GR807.4 of the Federation Rules)

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A non member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20.00 non member registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are excepted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF Introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. Also exempted from this requirement are citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 8) USEF beginning novice division; 9) assistant handlers in dressage Sport Horse Breeding Classes; 10) USEA beginning Novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage sport horse breeding classes. Effective 12-1-09.

AMATEUR STATUS

All riders in Amateur classes must have an Amateur Card if over the age of 18. Riders must present this card or make application for one before entering the ring. Applications for amateur cards will be available in the Show Office for a fee of \$30. Amateur/Owner to Ride may also include an amateur member of the owner's family. Combined ownership is not permitted in AOTR and JOTR classes unless all owners are members of the same family.

2011 AHA Medal Class Specifications

AHA HUNTER SEAT OVER FENCES MEDAL CLASS

- 1) To be shown over a course of not fewer than 6 obstacles with fence heights of 2'6" to 3' of which must include an oxer and two changes of direction (changes of lead).
- 2) Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required from USEF Equitation Division EQ113 Tests 1-7, 9-15, 17-19 (EC equivalent).

AHA SADDLE SEAT MEDAL CLASS

- 1) In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF (EQ120) Tests 1-15 (EC equivalent). Markers shall not be used. USEF Tests 16 may only be called for at the National Shows.

AHA REINING SEAT MEDAL CLASS

- 1) All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in the USEF Reining Division or (EC Equivalent)
- 2) Order of go will be done by draw
- 3) Bits must be dropped and inspected by the Judge or designated official, and all riders must dismount for this inspection. If called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
- 4) Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
- 5) In the event the total score is tied, the tie will first be broken by the exhibitor with the highest equitation score. Should a tie still exist, the tie shall be broken by reining rules in RN103.2
- 6) It is mandatory that judges use the prescribed AHA Score Sheet for Reining Seat Equitation and that the score sheet or a copy be posted immediately after each class.

AHA HUNTER SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL CLASS

- 1) In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more tests from USEF Equitation Division, EQ 113, Tests From Which Judges Must Choose.

AHA WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL CLASS

- 1) In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF Arabian, Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division, Subchapter Western Horsemanship, Subchapter AR-26.



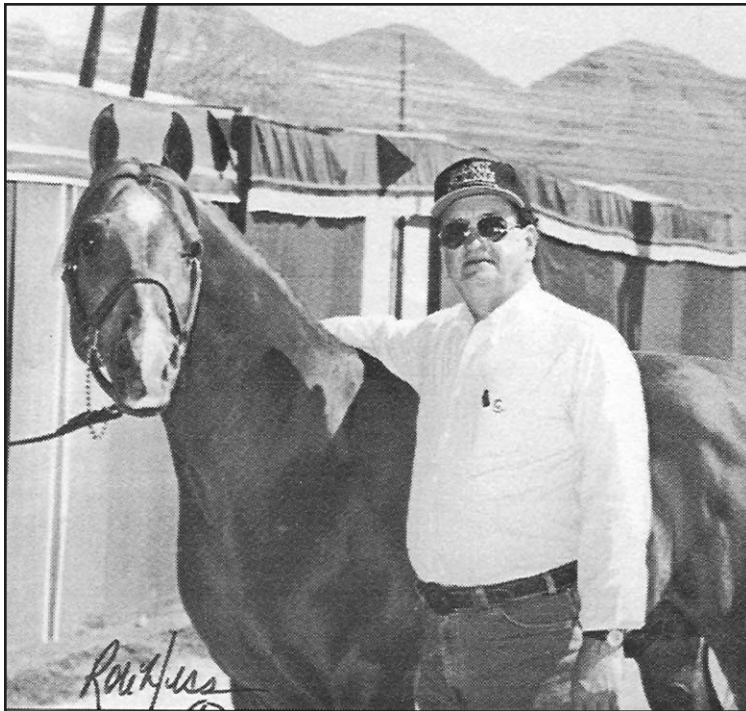

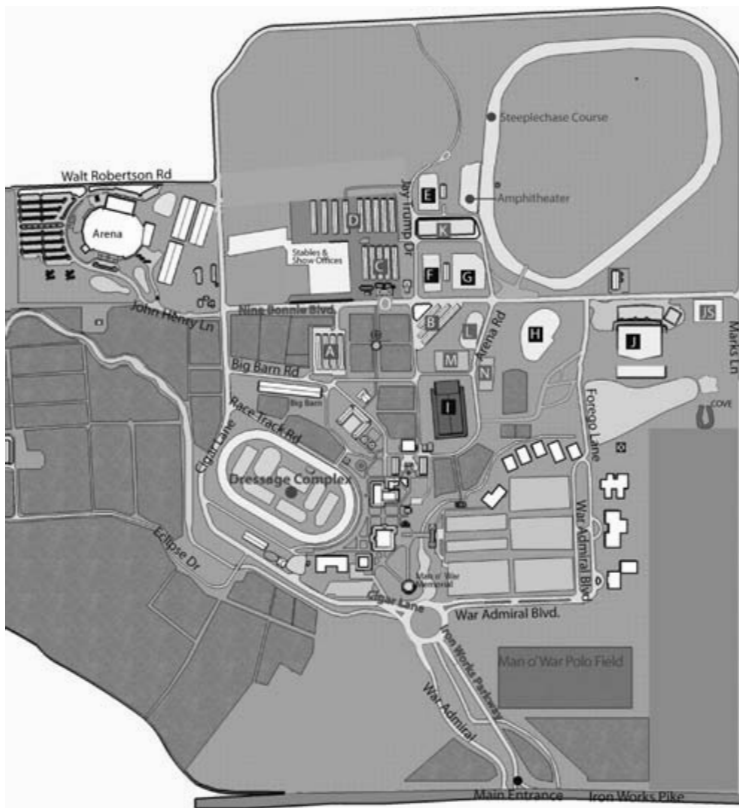
